

The Bitter/Persecuted Church

"And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: The first and the last, who was dead, and has come to life, says this: "I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich), and the blasphemy by those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the second death." ' "

CHURCH | BITTER/PERSECUTED

Smyrna (Greek: Σμύρνη) is an ancient city (present-day Izmir, Turkey). Izmir also incorporates the nearby ancient Biblical cities of Ephesus, Pergamon, and Sardis. Smyrna was founded by the Ionians (Coastal Greeks) at a central and strategic point on the Aegean coast of Anatolia (Asia Minor). Smyrna rose to prominence before the Classical Era.



CHURCH | KEY NOTE

This is the second church named in our study. The message to this church represents a period of unbelievable persecution, starting AD 303. Constantine (a known Catholic political) had returned to Nicomedia (Smyrna) from the eastern front by the spring of AD 303, in time to witness the beginnings of Diocletian's "Great Persecution," the most severe persecution of **Christians in Roman history.**





SMYRNA | RELEVANT TODAY

- **† Constantine the Great = Fake Christian**
- † Smyrna known for practicing idolatry
- † Polycarp = he wasn't a "Pope"
- † Smyrna means = bitterness & dead myrrh
- † Smyrna = suffered at the hands of the fake church
- † The Gospel That Hurts = the second death
- **† Smyrna's Price = the cost of the authentic**
